### Project Scope

The Woleebee Creek Mine Camp is situated approx. 350km NW of Brisbane. The camp is situated on a Greenfield site and will be completed over several stages and will ultimately support 2500 persons (mining crews, support crews, consultants and facilities staff).

CASA Engineering’s scope included supply, fabricate, deliver and erect covered walkways that adjoin/connect the various accommodation dongas, kitchen, gym and other facilities. We also supplied, fabricated, delivered and erected bus shelters that are positioned on the camp roads to facilitate the movement of persons within the camp to the mine site(s).

CASA provided integral design input to enable the majority of components to be fabricated off-site. CASA also utilized our own crane and transport – all factors that kept costs contained and improved completion timeframes for our client.
